Years ago, Marko Radisic had an idea. Well, we should call it a concept. It included sushi but went far beyond it. Somewhere, all bound up in the concept, were the words "Flirt" and "Lounge" and "Allendale." He'd better explain.

"I always wondered what you did for relaxation over here," said Mr. Radisic, a Serbian immigrant whose business was (and still is) distributing high-end wine. After years of globe-hopping (his father is a professional soccer coach), he had just moved his family to this prosperous, spread-out, SUV-driving zip code in northwestern Bergen County, and life seemed insular and singularly unexciting.

"One day I walked into the house," he went on, "and said to my wife, 'We're going to open a sushi place.' I loved South American food, so I figured, let's combine the South American and Asian concepts. I took the concept a little farther, and called it Flirt. People thought that was absolutely nuts, in a conservative area. Then I added loud music, and young male waiters, and things kind of took on their own life."
